10. Safety Officer Talk – Doug Bramley

Doug described a fatal boiler accident. The accident was caused by a boiler blow off valve which was made of material not allowed for boiler external piping. A word of caution, don't assume that the first valve adjacent to the boiler drum meets the code requirements. Some new boilers are delivered with valves that don't meet code regulations.

The user is responsible to ensure that valves and fittings meet the requirements of appropriate codes and regulations.
