## 6.0 Correspondence:

Art Smith commented on the boiler explosion that occurred in Ottawa this year at the Cliff St. power plant. Art did not get any boiler explosion pictures from the Ontario IPE branch as they were told by the Ontario Safety Authority the investigation was not complete. Do you remember the BCIT boiler explosion? Two years after the explosion the BCSA would not give you any information as the excuse was then, the boiler explosion can't be discussed as it is in the courts. Two or three years from now the Ontario Safety Authority will likely tell you it is in the courts. One man died and several were badly injured. Art Smith will be sending a letter out to the IPE membership addressing safety issues.

# 7.0 Reports

**Employment – Barry Brown:** Barry is now in charge of this committee, thanks Barry.

**Corporate Membership:** Bob Norton: Bob is preparing a letter to present to companies who employ power engineers explaining how they may sign up and pay for IPE members.

### Legislation:

Eric Steinson: Eric spoke of some recent changes and proposals affecting our profession and the general public. Including that the BCSA is now sending proposed changes directly to the provincial government without any consultation with the IPE or anyone in the power engineering community. A major concern is the proposal sent by the BCSA to the provincial government that if passed would eliminate the requirements for boiler inspectors. Gord Lindsay made a motion that the Area Director send a letter to the Minister of Housing and Social Development voicing our concern with the lack of consultation that now goes on, as well as the recent changes that are on the table. Motion was seconded by Gordon Beriault. Eric will write the letter.

Treasurers Report: Tanya Peric reported all accounts are in good order.

**Professionalism:** David Babich spoke of the first continuing competency course coming out starting in March 2010, more information to come.
